

CHAPTER 5

Comments on the Draft and Recirculated Draft EIR

Introduction

This chapter provides a list of all the written comments received during the Draft EIR public review period (October 3, 2006 to November 16, 2006) and during the public review period (from July 16, 2007 to August 29, 2007) for the Recirculated Draft EIR. A list of the attendees of the joint City Council/Planning Commission public hearings (from November 21, 2000 to March 7, 2007) on the Draft 2050 General Plan is also provided in this chapter, with summaries of these oral comments and responses provided in Chapter 4 “Public Hearing Comments and Responses”.

Response to Comments

Each of the comment letters identified above are provided on the following pages, with individual responses to each of the comment letters provided in Chapter 2 “Response to Comments on the Draft EIR” and Chapter 3 “Response to Comments on the Recirculated Draft EIR”. With the exception of the courtesy statements, introductions, and closings, the content of each letter has been divided into individual comments. To assist in referencing comments and responses, each commenter has been assigned a letter (such as “A”) and each individual comment within the letter a corresponding number (such as “A-1”). For the joint letter from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and the California Department of Fish and Game, for example, the first comment is referred to as “A-1”, the second comment as “A-2”, and so forth. The responses to each comment are formatted in a similar fashion.

Comments which present opinions about the project unrelated to environmental issues or which raise issues not directly related either to the adequacy or substance of the Draft EIR or to environmental issues are noted without a detailed response. Comments received on EIR sections or topics not included as part of the Recirculated Draft EIR (see Recirculated Draft EIR, July 2007) may not require a response, per CEQA Guidelines Section 15088.5(f)(2).

Where changes to the Draft EIR text result from these responses to comments, those changes are presented in Chapter 6 “Changes and Edits to the Draft and Recirculated Draft EIR” of this document, with changes shown by underlying new text (e.g., new text) and strike out text to be deleted (e.g., ~~deleted text~~).
